The Roderick Award of Courage Founders Committee is seeking nominations for the 2010 Roderick Award of Courage. The award recognizes a Williamson County hero, who, like Roderick, the celebrated civil war horse, displayed courage, loyalty and bravery in the face of adversity. The award will be presented March 5, 2010, at Roderick Place in Thompson's Station in commemoration of the 147th anniversary of the Battle of Thompson's Station.

The deadline for submissions is October 31, 2009.

General Criteria for nominees:

- Nominee can be living or deceased
- Nominee must live or work in Williamson County
- Nominee can be eligible for a single act of heroism and/or heroic achievements
- Act of heroism could have occurred outside Williamson County, i.e., military service
- Nominee can be an individual or small group
- Act of heroism must have taken place after January 1, 2008
- There will be no limits based on age, color, creed, religion or gender
- Nominee may be an animal
